LEAVE A LEGACY PROJECTS UPDATE: The annual Leave a Legacy Auction raises a significant amount of funds for non-budgeted items and large-scale projects that enhance the learning environment at Trinity Lutheran School. Past projects have included technology and security upgrades. The 2017 Legacy Auction raised funds to add a fence along 5th Avenue to provide additional safety and security measures for the students as they have Recess and PhyEd outside when weather permits. While this project has been on hold multiple times for multiple reasons, the funding remains set aside. The fence was purchased. The Properties Ministry is working on a plan to have the fence installed by the end of the current school year. 2018 Legacy funds were raised to overhaul the Library, including new books, shelving, seating, and potentially carpet. The Legacy Committee is actively working on this project now. The 2019 Leave a Legacy Auction is already in the planning stages. Some of their responsibilities and authority have become confusing, and some board meetings have become unnecessary or ineffective. Through “Built on the Rock: The Healthy Congregation’s Leader Pack,” we learned options for different organizational structures. Our church leaders have desired to revise our structure to more accurately reflect the changes in our organization and provide improved functionality for the future.

Please join us on Saturday, April 27th from 9-11am in the Spiritual Life Center as Pastor Holdorf and Bryon Graff lead a workshop on preparing for a change in structure. They will provide an outline for the body of Christ to be involved in living out the mission God has called us to.
