DEBT REDUCTION UPDATE: 35% of all Reaching Up and Reaching Out (RURO) donations goes toward additional principle on Trinity's debt. So far, all of that 35% has paid down the Thrivent Loan, which currently has \$745,750 in principle remaining. We have paid down over \$40,000 of additional principle on this loan through Reaching Up and Reaching Out since October 2016! Parish Council voted on January 16th to dedicate 75% of the RURO Debt Reduction dollars to additional principle on the Thrivent Loan, and 25% of those dollars to additional principle on the Endowment Loan. This will allow us to continue to use 100% of RURO Debt Reduction dollars to pay down additional principle as it was intended, while showing a commitment to paying back the Endowment Loan taken out in September.
