**SUNDAY SCHOOL RED LETTER CHALLENGE** We want to thank everyone for contributing to the Red Letter Challenges. We were successful in meeting our Week #2 Challenge. We have collected a great number of soup

cans, and we will not need to collect any more cans at this time. **Our Week #5 Challenge** is continuing through Thanksgiving: Boys vs. Girls in Sunday School & Men vs. Women in the Congregation.
